- No exhibitor will be allowed in the barn before 7:00 am on Wednesday, September 1.
- All Extreme Trail Rider Challenge horses must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI).

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS/CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION

All horses being exhibited at the Nebraska State Fair must meet all of the equine health requirements prior to entering the Nebraska State Fairgrounds or at unloading time, which are found at the following link: [2021 Equine & Equine Event Livestock Health Requirements](#). ENTRY DEADLINE DATE

Entries must be made online at www.Horseshowing.com by on August 15, 2021.

PARKING

1. All vehicles are required to park in places designated by the Fair Management. The Fair Management assumes no obligation and no liability for any theft or damage that may occur to the vehicle or its contents. No vehicle will be allowed to park for the sole purpose of advertising.
2. Designated equine parking areas will require a permit to enter. This permit must be requested on the entry form and is for the sole use of the exhibitor.

EQUINE EXHIBITOR RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Nebraska State Fair [General Equine Information, Rules and Regulations](#) apply to this and every department. Please refer to these sections. By submitting entry to the Nebraska State Fair, you agree to and will abide by these rules.
2. An open blank check will be required at the show office at check-in to cover added classes and will be returned at check-out if no classes were not added.

ENTRIES

For 2021, the Nebraska State Fair will be accepting online entries for the Extreme Trail Rider Challenge. For information on entering go to: www.statefair.org. Click on the Competitions & Participate tab; Click GO under Competitions; Click GO under Equine Exhibitor; Scroll down to Equine Entry Books; Click on Extreme Trail Rider Challenge. Late entries will be accepted until the barn is full. A late fee of \$50.00 per exhibitor will apply for all entries received after August 15, 2021.

STALLS / GROUND FEES

1. The Extreme Trail Rider Challenge Horses will be stalled in the R Barn.
2. Stalls will be available after 5:00 pm on Wednesday, September 1
3. Stall assignments will be made by the Extreme Trail Rider Challenge Superintendent(s). In the case of a shortage, the Superintendent(s) will have the right to reassign pens, tack pens, etc.
4. All horses occupying stalls must pay a stall fee. Whether entered for competition and judging. Stalls will not be assigned or available unless stall fees are accompanied.
5. Complete the stabling list for all owners and exhibitors who wish their animals to be stalled together.
6. All exhibitors must work out of stalls, rather than out of trailers, due to the lack of available parking around the arenas.
7. Assigned stall chart will be posted.

DOG POLICY

Due to requirements of the liability insurance carrier and policy of all major livestock shows, NO dogs are allowed on the Nebraska State Fairgrounds, in parking lots or in buildings other than those for direct competition or service animals. All dogs must be on a leash. There shall be no loose or unattended dogs on the fairgrounds. No dogs will be permitted in the animal barns, in tie outs or the Midway, except during authorized events and sanctioned dog shows. Dogs entered in Nebraska State Fair special performances or competitive events will be allowed on grounds or in buildings during performance or competition only.

AWARDS

Premiums totaling \$1,000.00 will be awarded. Payback & Buckles
A TROPHY BUCKLE will be awarded for the Champion & Reserve Champion over all.

Rosettes for the top 10 riders who are in the finals. 1st through 10th place.

Rosettes will be awarded for each Course in each Division 1st through 8th place.

PAYOUT from finals round:

1 st Place	\$300.00
2 nd Place	\$250.00
3 rd Place	\$150.00
4 Place	\$100.00

SHOW FORMAT

All entries will exhibit twice. Once on Course 1. Once on Course 2. Rosettes will be awarded on each course and in each division.

Each entry's Course 1 and Course 2 scores will be added together. The top 10 rider scores overall will come to ride in the Finals. A Champion and Reserve Champion Trophy Buckle, rosettes 1st thru 10th and Premium Money will be awarded based on the scores of the FINALS ROUND.

Course 1 & 2 maps will be available at 5:00 pm the day before the show. The course map for the Finals Round will be available approximately 4:00 pm the day of the show.

JUDGING

- Each obstacle is scored from 0 – 10. The score is based on horsemanship, the horse's willingness and fluidity of execution at each obstacle.
- You have 30 seconds to complete each obstacle. After 30 seconds, the judge will ask you to move on. You cannot move on until the judge signals you on.
- The course has a time limit. If you run out of time, a whistle will blow, and you will immediately leave the arena. You will receive points for the obstacles you have completed. Failure to leave is a DQ.
- Each ride is timed. If you complete the course within the time limit, you are eligible to receive "time-points". The fastest ride receives 10 points. Rides within 20 seconds receive 9 points, rides within 40 seconds receive 8 points and so on.

SHOW RULES

1. All riders will compete in the **division of their choice**.

Divisions are: Open
Amateur
Green/Young Horse
Youth

2. A horse may only be exhibited once.
3. A rider may enter more than one horse.
4. By signing an entry form, the exhibitor agrees to abide by the Nebraska State Fair General Livestock Information Rules and Regulations, the Equine Information, Rules and Regulation and the Trail Rider Challenges are available at www.TrailRiderChallenge.com. The exhibitor also agrees to abide by the IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics.
5. Trail Rider Challenge and Nebraska State Fair will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to or be caused by any horse exhibited at the show or for any article of any kind of nature that may be lost or destroyed or in way damaged.
6. The Trail Rider Challenge rules will be enforced.
7. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except those performing official duties.
8. Riders must wear proper attire. Dress to ride in front of an audience. Long sleeve shirt, hat or helmet, jeans without holes and boots. English attire is welcome.
9. Rider numbers will be provided.
