Youth Dairy Show Exhibitors may enter dairy animals in both the Youth Regional Dairy Show and the Open Show, **BUT MUST MAKE SEPARATE ENTRIES FOR EACH SHOW**. The entry is not duplicated if the animal is identified as “both” under either show. This is for stalling purposes only. You will have the opportunity to print a receipt for those entered, if desired, as your confirmation of entry.

YOUTH DAIRY SHOW ORDER

Registered and Grade animals of each breed will show together. The show order will be as follows: Jersey, Milking Shorthorn, Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, and Holstein Heifer classes in all breeds will show first, followed by the selection of Supreme Junior Champion & Reserve Supreme Junior Champion, followed by cow classes in all breeds and selection of Supreme Senior Champion & Reserve Supreme Senior Champion.

Showmanship Classes - age 10-11; age 12-13; age 14-16 and age 17-21 by January 1 of the current year.

Heifer Classes by breed - Junior Champions selected at the conclusion of breed classes.

Selection of Supreme Junior Champion & Reserve Supreme Junior Champion.

Cow Classes by breed (Production awards will be given as animals are shown in class). Senior champions selected at the conclusion of breed classes.

YOUTH DAIRY SHOW RULES

- A. Nebraska State Fair [General Livestock Information, Rules and Regulations](#), [Health Requirements](#) and Regional Youth Dairy Show rules apply to this department. Please refer to these sections. By submitting entry to the Nebraska State Fair, you agree to and will abide by these rules.
- B. **HEALTH PAPERS** - All dairy cattle must be accompanied by appropriate health certificates. Health certificates (CVI) must be presented at check in. **ALL YOUTH DAIRY CATTLE MUST HAVE AN OFFICIAL ID ON THE CVI. (See General Livestock Health Requirements).**
- C. **NUMBER OF ENTRIES PER EXHIBITOR** – Open to any youth who is 10 years old and no older than 21 (January 1 of current year). No geographic limitations for youth exhibitors. Ownership of animals is required prior to June 15, 2021. Registered and identified grade female animals are eligible. Animal registration must include family farm or exhibitor's name OR be identified on 4-H or FFA identification form. Must present registration sheet or ID sheet at check in. Youth exhibitor may show a maximum of five (5) dairy animals. If regulations for your state require completion of Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) this rule applies to the Regional Youth Dairy Show.
- D. **ENTERING ANIMALS FOR THE SHOW** – All entries must be made individually by the exhibitor. Entry Fee is \$25.00 per head (\$15.00 bedding fee included) for animals shown in youth show only. These animals may be shown in the Open Class Dairy Show; separate entries must be made by Exhibitor. Online entry deadline is August 10, 2021 at 8:00 p.m.
- E. **ARRIVAL TIME** - Animals must be in place by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 4th.
- F. **STALLING** - Youth Dairy animals will be stalled among open dairy animals by chapters/counties.
- G. **BEDDING** - No straw is allowed for bedding. *W o o d c h i p s* for bedding are provided for each exhibitor.
- H. **QUALITY ASSURANCE TRAINING** - All exhibitors must have completed Quality Assurance training through an Extension or FFA program prior to the fair. Program attendance or completion of a test in your County Extension is required. Completion of training must be certified by County Extension staff or FFA Advisor.
- I. **DAIRY CATTLE JUNIOR HERD** - Exhibitors who have made entry in the Dairy Cattle Junior Herd Class must present their records (as indicated in the Dairy Production Class description) to verify production to the show superintendent when animals are checked in. Dairy Cattle Junior Herd may consist of both 4-H and FFA animals but each animal must be owned by the same exhibitor. Exhibitor may enter one Junior Dairy Herd. See [Dairy Cattle Junior Herd Score Sheet](#).
- J. **SUPREME CHAMPIONS** - A Supreme Junior Champion, Reserve Supreme Junior Champion, Supreme Senior Champion and Reserve Supreme Senior Champion will be selected. Junior breed champions will return for the Supreme Junior Champion and Senior breed champions will return for the Supreme Senior Champion. The Supreme Junior Champion will be selected at the conclusion of the heifer classes and the Supreme Senior Champion will be selected one-half hour after the conclusion of the cow classes. The Supreme Junior Champion will be awarded \$100 and the Reserve Supreme Junior Champion will be awarded \$50. The Supreme Senior Champion will be awarded \$150 and the Reserve Supreme Senior Champion will be awarded \$100.
- K. **RELEASE OF DAIRY CATTLE** – Dairy cattle will be released at noon or when you are done showing.
- L. **PREMIUMS** - Premiums will be paid out as follows: Purple - \$30, Blue - \$28, Red - \$26. Dairy Herds are eligible for premium money; showmanship will not be paid a premium. Due to the youth dairy show being handled independently of 4-H and FFA, the premium checks will be issued prior to other 4-H and FFA premium money. Premium checks will be issued by the Nebraska State Fair and sent to exhibitor.

NOTE:

- Animals born after April 30, 2021 are not eligible to show in the individual classes or in dairy herds.
- Yearlings that have calved, freshening prior to show, must be shown in the Two Year Old class.
- If cows have been treated with RBST within the previous 30 days, they **CAN NOT** be milked in the parlor.

Production Award - A rosette will be awarded to each cow in milking classes that meets these production requirements (based on top 30% of herds in annual DHIA Summary of Herd Averages Report).

1. Awards presented on the basis of 305 2X ME records in progress for cows in milk and on the basis of the most recently completed 305 2X ME record for dry cows.
2. Exhibitor will provide DHIA herd identification and DHIA cow identification on entry form. Animal may qualify on either milk or protein production.
3. Show management will verify production information at check-in and complete the score card.

DAIRY CATTLE JUNIOR HERD

Exhibitor will enter three females in Junior Dairy Herd class. At least one of the three must be a cow that has freshened and has been fresh long enough to have a projected 305 day ME. All three must be of the same breed. Junior Dairy Herd may consist of both 4-H and FFA animals but each animal must be owned by the same exhibitor. Junior Dairy Herd class must be pre-entered with show entries. Production records to be used for scoring in the Junior Dairy Herd must meet the same criteria as those listed for Dairy Production Awards. Herds will be scored and awarded ribbons on the basis of the current [Dairy Cattle Junior Herd Score Card](#) located at the back of the entry book.

Supreme Junior Champion: \$100

Reserve Supreme Junior Champion: \$ 50

*To be selected at conclusion of heifer show on Sunday, September 5th

Supreme Senior Champion: \$150

Reserve Supreme Senior Champion: \$100

*These animals must be milked out after their breed show.

*The time for the Supreme and Reserve Champions is 30 minutes after last show on Sunday, September 5th.

DAIRY CATTLE JUNIOR HERD

REQUIREMENTS

- All three animals have been officially 4-H or FFA identified by the same 4-H or FFA member/exhibitor
- All three animals have been entered and exhibited (at the current show) by the same 4-H or FFA member/exhibitor
- All three animals must be the same dairy breed
- All three animals may be grade or registered, or any combination of grade and registered
- At least one of the three animals must be a cow that has freshened long enough to have a 305 2X ME record in progress. All producing animals (cows) must be on test according to guidelines. Refer to "Production (Protein) Points Awarded" guidelines.

- The show management will verify the production points on scorecard

To verify status of herd and individual cow records, exhibitors (herd management) must:

- Be testing at intervals less than 75 days
- Present test sheets within 90 days of show date
- Produce most recent 203, 303, 330 or documented entitled individual cow page
