Position Description

The Avenue of Breeds Superintendent will oversee, manage the designated area for the Avenue of Breeds, providing direction and leadership to daily volunteers, and be responsible for the well-being of livestock. They will report directly to the Livestock & Equine Manager at the Nebraska State Fair Office in Grand Island, Nebraska.

A successful candidate will be a person that can positively communicate with the general public to positively advocate for agriculture. They will have excellent oral communication skills. The applicant will be able to effectively manage people. They will have great organizational skills and be very detailed oriented.

Time Period: August 25th-September 5th, along with additional days for set-up and clean-up

- The position will be expected to work a set schedule during the duration of the Nebraska State Fair, which will include weekends and potentially early mornings and/or late nights.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for animal husbandry, care & management during fair
- Manage daily volunteer crews
- Maintain clean and welcoming environment
- Communicate with general public
- Manage feed and bedding inventory
- Assist with setting up and cleaning up Avenue of Breeds
- Additional duties as determined by supervisor.

Requirements:

- Candidate must be a high school graduate.
- Be able to attend required trainings
- Have a valid driver's license and able to operate a golf cart
- Be able to lift 50 pounds
