



2022 Nebraska State Fair – Livestock Load-in & Load-Out Personnel

Description

The Livestock Load-In and Load-Out Personnel will be responsible for flow of livestock trailers through and around the livestock barns. This group will report directly to the Livestock and Equine Manager at the Nebraska State Fair in Grand Island, Nebraska.

The best fit will be a group that can positively communicate with people in a fast-paced environment. They will have excellent oral communication skills. The ability to handle conflict is a must. This group must have a welcoming demeanor, as they will be the first face that welcomes exhibitors to the Nebraska State Fair. The group must be able to follow plans with minimal supervision.

Time Period: total of 11 days August 26th-September 5th

- Personnel will be expected to work a set schedule during the duration of the Nebraska State Fair, which will include weekends and potentially early mornings and/or late nights.

Responsibilities:

- Communicate with security and Brunks lot to facilitate efficient trailer flow
- Provide directions to exhibitors where to load/unload
- Maintain steady flow of traffic, including monitoring exhibitor time loading/unloading
- Help trailers back up to open doors
- Assist with policing of pedestrians to maintain safety of everyone
- Additional duties as determined by supervisor.

Requirements:

- Be able to work outside for long periods of time
- Have general livestock knowledge
- Able to run a radio
- Be able to lift 50 pounds
