

NEBRASKA STATE FAIR COMMERCIAL EXHIBITOR INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

Any exhibitor or concessionaire who wishes to exhibit at the Nebraska State Fair is required to provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance to our office before July 1st, 2022. No booth will be allowed to set up without having proof of insurance on file.

- General Business Liability Limits of: \$1,000,000 Each Occurrence
\$1,000,000 Product Liability
- **The Certificate must name The Nebraska State Fair Board, Fonner Park Exposition and Events Center, The Hall County Livestock Improvement Association, and the City of Grand Island as additional insured for the Fair dates of August 26th – September 5th, 2022, and also covering any move in/tear down days preceding/following the Fair.**
- Refer to Page 7 of the NSF Rules & Regulations, #11.1-11.3 for more information.
- Insurance Carrier must have a minimum AM Best Rating of A XV.
- The name of the “insured” exhibitor on the Certificate of Liability insurance provided must be the same as the Business and/or Contact name listed on the Exhibitor Contract. *Please list any DBA’s or LLCs for your business if different from that listed on the Certificate of Insurance.*
- Insurance declarations pages and automatic renewal policy statements will not be accepted as a valid form of insurance.
