



## Food and Beverage Prep-Safe Class

**THIS CLASS IS MANDATORY FOR ALL FOOD AND/OR BEVERAGE OPERATIONS**

The Central District Health Department (CDHD) will present a Prep-Safe Class (food and beverage certification class) on **Thursday August 25, 2022, at 3:00 P.M. in the Bosselman's Conference Center (BCC)**. The CDHD puts on the class, tracks compliance, and certifies all food and beverage operations at the Nebraska State Fair.

This class is **FREE** to all Nebraska State Fair contracted concessionaires and those concession operations contracted through Wade Shows.

Operators who have more than one location must send a supervisor from each location.

**Concessionaires and staff who participated in 2020, MUST be re-certified in 2022.**

**Concessionaires and staff who participated in 2021 are not required to be re-certified in 2022.**

### **Potential Exemptions:**

1. Personnel from concessions who attended this class at the 2022 Fair. If you have new personnel in your food stands, the new people must attend the class so that each stand is supervised by someone who has a valid permit.
2. Completion proof of a Food Handlers course for operation in the City of Grand Island, NE or a national ServSafe (2-day class).
3. Completion proof of a level 3 or 4 Food Managers course by the person who will be on site at the food service location throughout all open hours of the Fair.
4. Completion certificate of alternative proof of an equivalent class in another state must receive exception from CDHD on-site management.

### **Procedure to request exemption:**

Bring Certificate to CDHD Officials at the BCC between 2:30-3:00pm on Thursday (8/25) and it will be considered for exemption. If your certificate is deemed acceptable, the certificate holder will be excused from participating in the 2022 CDHD Prep Safe Class.

- 3:00 P.M.: Class instruction
- 3:30 P.M.: Final test - passing scores must be achieved to receive completion certificate
