## 1. Entries

- a. All Nebraska State Fair Livestock Entries are online at <https://www.statefair.org/competitions/livestock-exhibitors>
- b. **Entry Fees.**
  - i. \$20 per head for each division entered
  - ii. \$15 per Pen (6' x 6') for animals – Specify when entering if pen bedded with straw or wood chips
  - iii. \$10 per Pen (6' x 6') for tack
  - iv. Designated livestock exhibitor parking areas will require a parking pass to be purchased. This parking pass can be purchased when completing online entries or at the livestock check-in trailer.
- c. All entries must meet health requirements (see Health Regulations and Health Requirements for Animals Exhibited at the 2022 Nebraska State Fair).
- d. No animals will be changed from one class to another after entry closing date, unless it is ineligible for the class in which it is entered.
- e. Origin of goats will be determined by the address of the exhibitor.
- f. Entries for pair/group classes must be made by the entry deadline.
- g. No late entries will be accepted after August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, no exception.
- h. Substitutions within the same age, same class and same owner will be accepted at check-in. Only one substitution for the original animal will be allowed. There will be no substitutions allowed for different age classifications or owners. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

## 2. Special Rules

- a. General Rules and Regulations and Health Requirements apply to this division as well as those rules listed below. By submitting entry to the Nebraska State Fair exhibitor agrees to abide by these rules.
- b. **Additional Health Regulations/Certificate of Veterinary Inspection**
  - i. **A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection MUST accompany all animals entered.**
  - ii. All goats being exhibited at the Nebraska State Fair will be examined for fungus prior to entering the Nebraska State Fairgrounds or at unloading time. If any live fungus is found, said animal will not be allowed onto the grounds.

- iii. Only animals showing NO signs of infectious or contagious diseases, such as ringworm or abscesses, will be allowed to show.
  - iv. Under NO circumstances may goats be exhibited which originate from scrapie-source/infected flocks or under quarantine for any reason.
  - v. All goats must be appropriately identified and comply with the USDA Scrapie Eradication Program Guidelines.
- c. Boer goats must be owned by individual or firm in whose name entry is made. Ownership must have occurred at least 30 days prior to the opening of the fair.
- d. Exhibitors may make as many entries as they wish in individual classes, but there will be a limit of two monetary awards for each exhibitor in individual classes. Each exhibitor will be allowed to show one entry in each group class, and receive only one monetary award in each group.
- e. Pen assignments will be made by the Superintendent. In the case of a shortage the Superintendent will have the right to reassign pens, tack pens, etc.
- f. All animals occupying pens must be entered for competition and judged. Pens will not be assigned or available unless entries include required pen fees.
- g. All exhibitors will be eligible to compete for the Herdsmanship Award (see Open Class Herdsmanship).
- h. **ABGA Sanctioned Show Rules**
- i. All goats must be registered prior to show dates in the American Boer Goat Association.
  - ii. Original registration certificates are required at time of show.
  - iii. All goats must have legible tattoos consistent with the registration certificate or the animal will be disqualified. Point winners from each class must be prepared to have their tattoos read and recorded.
  - iv. Birthdate listed on registration certificate will determine class shown in.
  - v. Bucks 96.86% Boer & lower and Does 49.99% Boer & lower are not eligible to be shown.
  - vi. Progeny of fresh Does will not be allowed in the ring with their dam.
  - vii. Any Doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and cannot prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.
  - viii. Animals owned by the presiding judge within 90 days prior to the show date cannot be shown.
  - ix. Only goats entered under their ABGA registration number will be eligible to earn points for their actual placings in the show as described in the ABGA 'Criteria for Ennoblement of a Boer Goat'. (See rule 1000 Ennoblement Program at <http://www.ABGA.org>).
