BEGIN ARRIVAL Monday, August 29th, 12:00 p.m.

WEIGH IN Monday, August 29, 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.

SHOW Monday, August 29th, 6:00 p.m.

ALL OUT Tuesday, August 30th, Noon

ENTRIES

1. Entry Fees

- a. \$25 per team (due at weigh in)

2. Additional Fees

- a. Stalling Fee: \$15 per stall per day or \$50 for 5 days, per horse
- b. Jump Out Fee: \$15 per day per horse
- c. Tack Stall: \$15 per stall per day or \$50 for 5 days,
- d. Gate Admission: \$5 Exhibitor Ticket, per day, per exhibitor or \$25 Exhibitor Wristband, 11-day pass
- e. Parking Pass: \$10 for Single Day Parking Pass, \$25 for 5 days, per vehicle. Designated equine exhibitor parking areas will require a parking pass to be purchased.

SHOW RULES

1. A total of \$5,000 will be paid out on a percentage basis for lightweight and heavyweight divisions. In addition, each trailer will receive a \$150 fuel certificate (This is per vehicle not per team).
2. There will be meeting of drivers after Weigh In
3. Pulling horses can stall at no charge in the White Racehorse Barns.
4. This will be a split-over weight pull.
5. Show staff, the driver and helpers with each team are the only ones allowed in the arena during the pulling competition.
6. Pull is 20' – Three trials to pull the distance. *No adding pulls together.
7. Ropes are 15' apart.
8. You may unhitch after each trial.
9. Three times away is a trial. * If sled moves it a trial.
10. No hitchers in front of the Driver.
11. Only one driver. You may have someone bring your team to the load, however; you may have the lines until Pull is done.
12. Unruly teams will be asked to park.
13. No heading of horses.
14. No touching of horses while hooked to sled unless a breakdown happens.
15. No tying horses together.
16. If there are only 2 pullers left on the last round they cannot pass, they will have to pull for 1st and 2nd placing.

17. All teams go to the arena together.
18. We will haul your eveners to and from the arena for you.
19. Pulling horse will be randomly blood tested, based on the decision of the Show Management. If positive test is found, the team will be disqualified. If team is disqualified, the remaining teams will be moved up in placing. The prize money and the results will be held until test results are received.
20. The judge's decision is final.

SPECIAL RULES

By entering the exhibitor agrees to abide by the Nebraska State Fair General Information Rules and Regulations, Equine Information Rules and Regulations. The exhibitor also agrees to abide by the IAFE National Code of Show Ring Ethics.

FEED AND BEDDING

Exhibitors will be permitted to bring onto the grounds a limited amount of feed, hay, and bedding. If you wish to purchase hay, feed, and bedding from the fair you can purchase it from Aurora Cooperative. You can pre-order feed and additional bedding by contacting Aurora Cooperative at 308-750-6653. You can also visit their feed store during the State Fair.
