#### 1. Entries

a. All Nebraska State Fair Livestock Entries are online at All Nebraska State Fair Livestock Entries are online at <u>https://www.statefair.org/competitions/livestock-exhibitors</u>

#### b. Entry Fees.

- i. \$10 per head for each division entered
- **ii.** \$15 per Pen (6' x 6') for animals Specify when entering if pen bedded with straw or wood chips
- **iii.** \$10 per Pen (6' x 6') for tack
- **iv.** Designated livestock exhibitor parking areas will require a parking pass to be purchased. This parking pass can be purchased when completing online entries or at the livestock check-in trailer.
- **c.** All entries must meet health requirements (see Health Regulations and Health Requirements for Animals Exhibited at the 2023 Nebraska State Fair).
- **d.** No animals will be changed from one class to another after entry closing date, unless it is ineligible for the class in which it is entered.
- e. Origin of sheep will be determined by the address of the exhibitor.
- f. Entries for pair/group classes must be made by the entry deadline. No entries will be accepted at the show.
- g. No late entries will be accepted after August 15th, 2023, no exception.
- **h.** Substitutions within the same age, same class and same owner will be accepted at check-in. Only one substitution for the original animal will be allowed. There will be no substitutions allowed for different age classifications or owners. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- i. Registration papers are not required.
- 2. Special Rules

**a.** General Rules and Regulations and Health Requirements apply to this division as well as those rules listed below. By submitting entry to the Nebraska State Fair exhibitor agrees to abide by these rules.

#### b. Additional Health Regulations/Certificate of Veterinary Inspection

- i. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection MUST accompany all animals entered.
- ii. All sheep being exhibited at the Nebraska State Fair will be examined for fungus prior to entering the Nebraska State Fairgrounds or at unloading time. If any live fungus is found, said animal will not be allowed onto the grounds.
- iii. Only animals showing NO signs of infectious or contagious diseases, such as ringworm or abscesses, will be allowed to show.
- iv. Under NO circumstances may sheep be exhibited which originate from scrapiesource/infected flocks or under quarantine for any reason.
- v. All sheep must be appropriately identified and comply with the USDA Scrapie Eradication Program Guidelines.

#### c. All sheep are to be slick shorn.

- d. Sheep must be owned by individual or firm in whose name entry is made. Ownership must have occurred at least 30 days prior to the opening of the fair.
- e. Exhibitors may make as many entries as they wish in individual classes, but there will be a limit of two monetary awards for each exhibitor in individual classes. Each exhibitor will be allowed to show one entry in each group class, and receive only one monetary award in each group.
- f. Pen assignments will be made by the Superintendent. In the case of a shortage the Superintendent will have the right to reassign pens, tack pens, etc.
- g. All animals occupying pens must be entered for competition and judged. Pens will not be assigned or available unless entries include required pen fees.
- h. All exhibitors will be eligible to compete for the Herdsmanship Award (see Open Class Herdsmanship).
- i. Exhibitors also entered in the FFA Sheep Show will be allowed to remain in the barn. All other exhibitors will need to be completely out by noon (or at the discretion of the superintendent).
