1. Entries

- a. All Nebraska State Fair Livestock Entries are online at https://www.statefair.org/competitions/livestock-exhibitors
- b. Entry Fees
 - i. \$50 per head for each division entered Includes first bedding.
 - ii. \$50 for additional stall spaces (limited to 3 per exhibitor)
 - iii. Designated livestock exhibitor parking areas will require a parking pass to be purchased. This parking pass can be purchased when completing online entries or at the livestock check-in trailer.
- c. All entrants must have read, be familiar with and are subject to the Nebraska State Fair General Livestock Information, Rules and Regulations, and Health Requirements for animals exhibited at the Nebraska State Fair.
- d. No late entries will be accepted after August 15th, 2024, no exception.
- e. There is no limit to the number of animals an exhibitor may enter in this division or in any one of these classes. Premiums will be paid in accordance with the premium schedule listed in this division.
- f. Substitutions under the same owner will be accepted at check-in. Only one substitution for the original animal will be allowed. There will be no substitutions allowed for different divisions or owners. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- g. Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 10th place in all classes.
- h. Those exhibitors staying for the FFA shows must be willing to move to accommodate the cleaning and re-bedding process.
- 2. Special Rules
 - a. Additional Health Regulations/Certificate of Veterinary Inspection
 - i. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection MUST accompany all OUT OF STATE animals entered.

- ii. Nebraska origin animals do NOT require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.
- iii. Only animals showing NO signs of infectious or contagious diseases, such as ringworm or abscesses, will be allowed to show.
- b. An exhibitor may enter an unlimited number of females.
- c. Heifers may be bred, but not have calved by date of the show. No cow-calf pairs are allowed.
- d. Females must be two years of age or younger. Mouthing of the females will be subject to show management decisions.
- e. Steer Producing Showcase Females will be shown by weight and divided into a reasonable number of classes and divisions. There is no minimum or maximum weight.
- f. There will be no weigh-in. Exhibitors will have weight declaration information that will be obtained when the exhibitor picks up their exhibitor packet. Weight declaration must be completed by the deadline. <u>There will be no exceptions.</u> This weight declaration will be considered the official weight.
- g. A weigh back system will be used. <u>All females will be weighed before entering the show ring.</u> No reweighs will be allowed once the animal has stepped off the scale. There will be a 5% tolerance from the declared weight and all animals outside of the 5% tolerance will be disqualified.
- h. Fitting is permitted. Unethical fitting practices as outlined in the General Livestock Rules and Regulations will be monitored for.
- i. No aerosol cans or pressurized cans of any sort are allowed <u>inside the Five Points</u> <u>Bank Arena</u> under any circumstance! Anyone using them will be excused from the Arena & sent back to the barn.
- j. No smoking or vaping is allowed in any barn or building.
- k. Stalling assignments will be made by the Superintendent. In the case of a shortage the Superintendent will have the right to reassign stalls, tack areas, etc. <u>Requests for</u> <u>individuals to be stalled together or next to will be considered but NOT guaranteed</u>. When entering please indicate stalling requests.
- 1. All animals occupying stalls must be entered for competition and judged.
- m. Cattle can only be washed in the designated wash racks.
- n. No dumping of manure or trash on either side of the barn except in designated dumpsters. All manure must be placed in wheelbarrows or manure carts. NO MANURE IN TRASH CANS, NO TRASH IN MANURE DUMPSTERS OR WHEELBARROWS, PLEASE! All non-manure trash needs to be placed into trash dumpsters.
- Only overhead fans located in the front half of the stalling area will be allowed. NO BUTT FANS! Only 1 fan per animal will be allowed.
- p. All cattle, both in barns and tie-outs, must have neck ropes in addition to halters.
- q. Due to requirements of the liability insurance carrier and policy of all major livestock shows, NO dogs are allowed on the Nebraska State Fairgrounds, in parking lots or in buildings other than those for direct competition, or Service animals. All dogs must be on a leash. There shall be no loose or unattended dogs on the fairgrounds. No dogs will be permitted in the animal barns, in tie-outs or on the Midway, except during authorized events and sanctioned dog shows. Dogs entered in the Nebraska State Fair special performances or competitive events will be allowed on the grounds or in buildings during performance or competition events only.

r. BY ORDER OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL: Any and all lighting used by exhibitors must be securely fastened. The electrical boxes MUST be kept clear at all times. Also, the aisles must be maintained at all times in the Cattle Barn. Yellow lines have been painted on the floor designating those boundaries. ALL show equipment, blocking chutes, chairs, etc. MUST be kept within these boundaries at all times. In addition, any use of refrigerators, freezers, microwave ovens and electric cookers is strictly prohibited.
