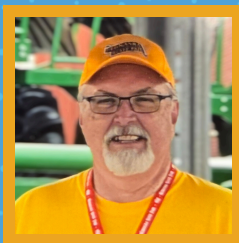


VOLUNTEER HIGHLIGHT
