

# AMERICAN HIGHLAND SHOW – RING 1

## DIVISION 100

### BREED REPRESENTATIVES:

1. All classes shall be governed by the rules of the American Highland Cattle Association and the Nebraska State Fair.
2. Owners must be members in good standing of the American Highland Cattle Association or Canadian Highland Cattle Society.
3. All animals must be owned by the owner and breeding stock registered with the American Highland Cattle Association or Canadian Highland Cattle Society.
4. Registration papers must be presented to show officials or AHCA representatives upon request.
5. Tattoos must be legible and correspond to registration papers.
6. Use of hormones or steroids in animals exhibited is prohibited.
7. Fullblood breeding cattle may not be dehorned.
8. All bulls 12 months or older must be shown with a nose ring or nose lead. Note: We recommend that bulls be experienced with nose ring or nose lead prior to showing the animal.
9. Registered and unregistered market animals (both pure and crossbred) and registered Sovereign heifers, will be included for the number of animals in a point show.
10. Only registered pure and crossbred market animals and registered Sovereign heifers will count toward the Premier Breeder and Exhibitor awards at all ROE shows.
11. Animals in group classes Get-of-Sire, Produce-of-Dam and Breeders Herd must be registered fullblood Highland cattle.
12. Also, all owners should be verified as current AHCA members and cattle entered on their entry forms are in their ownership.

## **COW/CALF PAIRS**

A calf in the cow/calf class must be the cow's natural calf, still nursing and a maximum of 250 days old.

Both the cow and calf must be registered fullblood Highland cattle.

The Champion American Highland Cow/Calf Pair will compete in the Supreme Cow/Calf Drive. Cow/calf pairs do **not** compete for overall champion female.

## **GROUP CLASSES**

Not eligible for Grand Champion. No entry fee is required, but must enter by the entry deadline. Only two entries per exhibitor per group class. Each animal must be shown in an individual class to be eligible for a group class.

**1032** Breeders' Six Head

Exhibitor must be breeder and first owner, identified by the same member code for the animals exhibited. Cattle owned by other exhibitors may be included provided the exhibitor of the breeders' six head is the breeder and first owner of the included animal(s). Animals must be exhibited in individual classes. Cattle bred and owned by a junior member(s) may be included if the exhibitor of the breeders' six head is an individual or married couple and is the parent or legal guardian of the junior member(s).
