1. Entries

a. All Nebraska State Fair Livestock Entries are online at

b. Entry Fees.

- i. Llama Halter – Dual Entry to ALSA & ILR REQUIRED - \$30 per class
- ii. Alpaca Halter – OPEN CLASS - \$15 per class
- iii. Performance Classes – can choose ALSA (\$15), ILR (\$15) or both (\$30), per class
- iv. Walking Fiber – ALSA Llama, OPEN Class Alpaca only - \$15 per class
- v. Required animal fees:
 1. ALSA - \$5 per animal. ALL exhibitors must pay an ALSA show fee per animal shown, as well as the parent of produce of dam and/or get of sire, even though she or he is not shown.
 2. ILR - \$3 per animal. ALL exhibitors must pay an ALSA show fee per animal shown, as well as the parent of produce of dam and/or get of sire, even though she or he is not shown.
 3. Non ALSA Member Fee is \$50 for adults & \$15 for youth
 4. ALSA no longer sanctions alpaca classes. No ALSA animal fees requires unless competing in performance classes.
- vi. \$15 per stall, **MUST provide own bedding**

- vii. Designated livestock exhibitor parking areas will require a parking pass to be purchased (\$25 per pass). This parking pass can be purchased when completing entries or at the check-in trailer.*
- c. All entries must meet health requirements (see Health Regulations and Health Requirements for Animals Exhibited at the 2026 Nebraska State Fair).
 - d. No animals will be changed from one class to another after entry closing date unless it is ineligible for the class in which it is entered.
 - e. No late entries will be accepted after August 15th, 2026, no exception.
 - f. Substitutions within the same age, same class and same owner will be accepted at check-in. Only one substitution for the original animal will be allowed. There will be no substitutions allowed for different age classifications or owners. NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - g. **Exhibitors arriving prior to the posted arrival time are not allowed on the grounds. Anyone that brings animals or tack onto the grounds without prior approval of the Agriculture Director will forfeit their premiums.**

2. Special Rules

- a. General Rules and Regulations and Health Requirements apply to this division as well as those rules listed below. By submitting entry to the Nebraska State Fair exhibitor agrees to abide by these rules.
- b. **Additional Health Regulations/Certificate of Veterinary Inspection**
 - i. **A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection MUST accompany all OUT OF STATE animals entered.**
 - ii. **Nebraska origin animals do NOT require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.**
- c. Stall assignments will be made by the Superintendent. In the case of a shortage the Superintendent will have the right to reassign stalls, tack stalls, etc.
- d. All animals occupying stalls must be entered for competition and judged. Stalls will not be assigned or available unless entries include required stall fees. Nursing baby llamas brought with their dams must be entered in the costume class to fulfill the requirement of stall occupation. Both dam and baby can show as one unit in costume.
- e. For halter classes, all llamas and alpacas MUST have ILR or CLRC registrations. Animals in non-breeder classes do not need to be registered All Alpacas AOA, ARI or CLRC registrations.
- f. For performance classes, animals do not need to be registered animals. Alpacas and llamas will compete in the same performance classes in both ALSA and ILR.
- g. The order of the show is subject to change from the entry book listing pending outcome of the decision of the judge prior to show. The judge will notify all exhibitors of the order at the judge's meeting held prior to the show. The judge may also combine classes if not enough entrants to compete to meet criteria for qualifying for Grand Nationals. Judges' meetings will be held 1 hour prior to the start of the show each day. Any changes to the order of the show will be officially announced at this time. Please be aware of this and remain flexible until final announcements are made for show times and class schedules. Thank you in advance for your consideration of this.

OPEN ALPACA HALTER SHOW

1. All alpaca halter animals need to be registered alpacas.
2. PLEASE MAKE NOTE: As per 2026 ALSA handbook updated ALSA will not sanction alpaca halter shows. Instead, all alpaca halter shows will need to be open class.
3. Color Divisions: The guide for these descriptions shall be the Alpaca Registry Inc. When fewer than 4 alpacas in Level I shows are present in either Color Groups White, Light or Fawn, these Color Groups may be combined. When fewer than 4 alpacas in Level I shows are present in either Color Group Brown or Black, these Color Groups may be combined. When fewer than 4 alpacas in Level I shows are present in either Color Group Gray or Mixed, these Color Groups may be combined.
4. Age Divisions: Under 24 months and 24 months and older. Based on age at time of show.
