1. All classes will be governed by the rules and regulations of the Piedmontese Association of the United States (PAUS) and the Nebraska State Fair.
2. **Standard of Excellence (SOE) Show Rules**
 - a. Only Full bloods and Purebreds will be allowed to show in SOE shows. Purebreds are stated as the following: 15/16 Piedmontese or higher for females and 31/32 or higher for males. All Purebreds shall have the color and characteristics of the Piedmontese breed to show in PAUS SOE Shows.
 - b. All animals must be registered with one of the Associations; if the animal is not registered, they can show with an affidavit. An affidavit is only good for one show and for a breeder to receive an affidavit on an animal the following must be completed:
 - i. Cattle registration application must be paid for and in the PAUS office.
 - ii. Hair must be received by Geneseek, Inc.
 - iii. NOTE: No animal over a year of age will be issued an affidavit.
 - c. At SOE shows, other than the breed's National Show, SOE points are credited to both the sire and dam of a calf in individual classes.
 - d. To qualify for SOE status, a show must have 20 entries with a minimum of 5 breeders exhibiting at the previous year.
 - e. They must maintain at least 20 entries with a minimum of 5 breeders showing to keep SOE status.
 - f. Official SOE point tabulations will be processed by the PAUS Show Committee Chair and verified by the PAUS office at the end of the show season.
 - g. All animals must be halter broke and leadable to present in the show ring.
 - h. Any unauthorized animals in the show ring will result in disqualification of the owner and/or the exhibitor in that class.
 - i. **ALL BULLS BORN PRIOR TO JANUARY 1 OF THE CURRENT YEAR MUST BE SHOWN WITH A BULLRING OR NOSE CLAMP. BULLS NOT SHOWN WITH ONE OF THESE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

1936	Exhibitor's Herd	Four animals, any age, both sexes must be represented. All must be owned by the same exhibitor. No SOE points are awarded in this class.	Ribbon
