Welcome to the 2026 Nebraska State Fair High School Rodeo. We are excited to see all the new and returning contestants. Here is some important information to help make the process of entering the NSF a success for everyone.

- **HORSES**

- A. **NO** CVI is required for “In State” horses.
- B. **NO** EIA(Coggins)required for“In State”horses.
- C. The Nebraska State Fair strongly recommends that **ALL** horses also be vaccinated **PRIOR** to coming to the Fair for equine influenza and within 1 to 6 months prior to the Fair for EHV.
- D. If an emerging disease is detected in Nebraska or any other state, additional requirements may be put in place.

- **CHECK IN (See attached map)**

- Main Check in will be held at JBS parking lot.
- Ropers who entered the Breakaway Sunday night will go to a secondary location. I will be in contact with those individuals.
- CHECK IN TIMES
 - Sunday, September 6th ~ 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm (JBS)
 - Sunday, September 6th ~ 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm (Luebbe Lot) Breakaway only
 - Monday, September 7th ~ 6:00 am to 11:00 am (Luebbe Lot)

- **ADMISSION/PARKING**

- **Contestants will get in free**
- Families will need to purchase tickets. \$10 per person (fee includes Sunday and Monday).
- Parking Pass - \$15 per vehicle
 - There is no pen building this year.
 - Around the stall barns please be respective of space and **ABSOLUTELY NO PLUGGING TRAILER INTO BARNs.**
 - **ABSOLUTELY NO SAVING PARKING SPOTS. WE WILL PARK YOU.**
- Stalls - \$20 per horse per night
